Safeguarding

As the days grow longer and the evenings lighter, children naturally want to spend more time playing outside. While this is a wonderful opportunity for fun and physical activity, it's important to ensure their safety.

- 1. Supervision is Key: whenever possible, supervise children while they play outside. If direct supervision isn't feasible, make sure they play in groups and check in regularly.
- **2. Teach Road Safety:** with more children playing outside, it's crucial to reinforce road safety rules.
- **3. Stranger Danger Awareness:** educate children about the importance of not talking to strangers and what to do if they feel uncomfortable or threatened.

Attendance





Non-uniform day Friday 23rd May £1 contribution in cash or on parentpay


