Booking your TEAMS Parents' Evening Appointments



We look forward to seeing you all at our "virtual" Parents' Evenings on Tuesday 15th and Thursday 17th February 2022. If you have not yet already made your appointment simply log on to parentmail and select parents' evening on the left of your screen, then select Date – Class - Book slot.

If you would like to be contacted on a different email address to the one we have **OR** if two of you in different households would like to join (where parents don't live together), then please, enter these email addresses in the comments box.

If you would rather receive a phone call from the teacher please put your contact number in the notes section when booking.

Booked Parents' Evening Appointments

Once you have made your appointment, unless you have requested a phone call, the meetings will be held through Teams and you will be able to join via the links already sent to you via parentmail. If both parents would like to join from separate devices, you can both click on the link and you will be admitted to the call together. (Please share a device if you are in the same room to minimise echo and feedback.)



You can join the meeting when you are ready and will enter a "lobby". You

will be admitted to the meeting at the correct time by your child's teacher. The meetings will be a maximum of 10 minutes long and this will be strictly adhered to for the convenience of all parents. In line with our school protocol, all meetings will be recorded.

The teachers are looking forward to meeting with you and discussing your child's learning.

Nursery Applications

We have places in our excellent Nursery for September 2022. If you have a child who has their 3rd birthday before September 2022 or know somebody who is looking for a Nursery place, please collect and complete an application form which is available from the school front office, alternatively we can email the forms to you, just call us on 01934 427373.

All children are entitled to **15 hours FREE** childcare and education starting the term after their 3rd birthday.

In addition, some children may also be entitled to **30 hours FREE** childcare and education depending on their circumstances (see gov.uk).

Our Nursery offers **flexible sessions**- children could start as early as **8am** and finish at **3.30pm**. We provide water, milk and fruit daily and we also offer **hot meals** for children.

The Nursery is part of our successful Foundation Stage where children thrive by learning through play.

Are you interested in training to become a primary school teacher?

Our school is part of a growing number of schools leading the way in school-led teacher training. This is really important to us because it means we can choose the very best talent and develop them into first-rate teachers. Being able to choose who we train as teachers helps us in delivering the best outcomes for pupils in North Somerset.

Herons' Moor Academy is working in collaboration with five other North Somerset primary schools with Somerset SCITT as our accredited partner, and we are recruiting another group of trainee teachers to work in our School Direct consortium from September 2022. We would be very interested in hearing from anybody who is thinking of becoming a teacher. Eligible people need to have a degree, have a passion for teaching and education and the commitment and determination to undertake an intensive year of training, 90% of which is school-based.

If you are interested, the first step is to have a conversation with me as Principal. I will be able to tell you more about this exciting teacher training opportunity.
