Nursery Applications

We have places in our excellent Nursery for September 2021. If you have a child who has their 3rd birthday before September 2021 or know somebody who is looking for a Nursery place, please collect and complete an application form which is available from the school front office, alternatively we can email the forms to you, just call us on 01934 427373 or email.

All children are entitled to 15 hours FREE childcare and education starting the term after their 3^{rd} birthday.

In addition, some children may also be entitled to **30 hours FREE** childcare and education depending on their circumstances (see GOV.UK).

Our Nursery offers **flexible sessions**- children could start as early as **8am** and finish at **3.30pm**. We provide water, milk and fruit daily and we also offer **hot meals** for children.

The Nursery is part of our successful Foundation Stage where children thrive by learning through play.

Nursery

Nursery children to arrive 0900-0915 and will leave by 1500.

Reception

Reception children to arrive 0845-0900 and will leave 1500-1515.

KS1

Year 1 to arrive 0830-0845 and will leave at 1500

Year 2 to arrive 0845-0900 and will leave at 1515.

KS2

Years 3 and 5 to arrive 0830-0845 and will leave at 1500

Years 4 and 6 to arrive 0845-0900 and will leave at 1515.

Please note, if your child is supposed to be in school by 08.45, that is the time lessons will start as they are finishing at 3.00pm.

Summer Season



- Now we are in the Hayfever season. We are happy to hold extra medication in school for your child, provided you have completed the medical consent form.
- On sunny days please apply 'all day' sun protection cream before your child leaves home.
- We would encourage the wearing of sunhats on sunny days.
- We ask that you send your child to school with their water bottle filled with <u>only</u> <u>fresh water</u>. Thank you very much.

Foundation Stage – Should your child be particularly sensitive to the sun due to fair skin for example, it may be possible for the class teacher or teaching assistant to apply sun cream to your child. If this is the case, please discuss the matter with your child's class teacher and sign a medical consent form which can be obtained from the school front office.

Key Stages 1 & 2 – Older children, who may also be particularly sensitive to the sun and are able to apply sun cream themselves, may bring sun cream to school. However, it must be labelled with their name and handed to their class teacher for safe keeping.



Please can we remind you that at Herons' Moor we expect all children to be in the correct uniform. In particular, it is really important that our children wear sensible footwear so they are safe. For health and safety reasons, jewellery is not allowed, apart from watches and stud earrings.

We are proud of how smart our children look in their uniform. The staff and school councillors believe it gives the academy an identity and encourages the children to take pride in their appearance. Please make sure that all uniform and PE kit is **labelled with your child's name**.
