# <u>Reception Intake September 2024 (for children born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 - 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020)</u>

From 1<sup>st</sup> September you may apply for a Reception place for your child if your child was born between the dates above. Applications may be made online at <u>www.n-somerset.gov.uk</u> or you may obtain an application pack from the School Admissions and Transport Team at the Town Hall on 01275 888328. Please note that packs are not available from school. **The closing date for the first round of allocations is at Midnight on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024.** 

Please note a change in our Admissions Policy. If you currently have a child in Year 6, the sibling rule still applies, so you will have more chance of getting your child a place.



Please remember that if your child attends our Nursery, this sadly **DOES NOT** guarantee you a place in Reception, you need to apply for a place in the same manner as all other parents. If you have any questions concerning this procedure please ask a member of staff or contact the Town Hall.

The trees can be 2D or 3D and can take any form you like. The trees need to be able to be carried by a child into school. **We would like these to be brought into school on Thursday 7th December**. The children will then all have an opportunity to follow the trail around the building in the last week of term. This is not mandatory; it is just an extra way to find some joy and brighten up the school corridors.

# <u>Children's Disco - Friday 8th December 2023. KS1 and KS2 pupils only are invited.</u>





KS1 (Years 1-2) will be from 4:45pm to 5.30pm, followed by KS2 (Years 3-6) 5.45pm to 6.30pm.

The cost of the Disco will be £3.00 per child **payable on ParentPay and tickets must be purchased in advance. This small increase is because refreshments are now included in the ticket price.** Refreshments will be available, and no money is needed. Your child will be offered a drink of water or squash, some crisps or popcorn and some sweets.

If your child would like to attend, please make payment on ParentPay before end of the school day on **Thursday 7th December.** 

This is a children only event therefore to assist with safety and security no adults are permitted to remain in the disco without prior DBS clearance.

Please note <u>children are not permitted to bring mobile phones or cameras</u> with them to avoid problems with photographs being published on social media without another parent's consent. If a child needs to contact you a member of staff will be able to do this for them.

Children should arrive at the Front Office for the disco and we will ask you to take your child's coat with you. Adults must collect through the Campus and **no child will be permitted to walk home alone.** Please comply with this as we need to ensure the safety of all children.
