Diabetes UK - Thursday 9th June

As part of our charity fundraising this year, we are holding a 'Blue Day' on Thursday 9th June, in support of diabetes UK. The school council voted for this charity as one of the members has type 1 diabetes. The children and staff will all be able to wear blue on this day (as this is the colour of type 1 diabetes).



We will have an assembly in the morning run by a representative from the charity raising awareness of diabetes and what it means for children and people living with the condition.

During the day the children and staff will also be having a go at some balloon activities also. This means keeping the balloon balanced and level whilst doing a range of different activities (the balloon represents the blood sugar levels

The children will be able to then take their balloons home (if they have managed to not pop them by this point) and have a go at different activities that they couldn't do in school e.g., riding a bike, washing up etc. Please take pictures and share these with us at school, we would love to see them! We just ask for a donation for the charity for your child coming in in the colour blue and taking part in the balloon activities.

Nursery Applications

We have places in our excellent Nursery for September 2022. If you have a child who has their 3rd birthday before September 2022 or know somebody who is looking for a Nursery place, please

Children are entitled to 15 hours FREE childcare and education per week starting the term after their 3rd birthday. Parents may also be entitled to 30 hours FREE childcare and education (see gov.uk).

Our Nursery offers flexible sessions- children could start as early as 8am and finish at 3.30pm. We provide water, milk and fruit daily and we also offer hot meals for children.

Summer Season



- Now we are in the hayfever season, we are happy to hold extra medication here for your child, provided you have completed the medical consent form.
- On sunny days please apply 'all day' sun protection cream before your child leaves home.
- We would encourage the wearing of sun hats on sunny days.
- Please send your child in with a named water bottle (only water in it please).

Foundation Stage – Should your child be particularly sensitive to the sun due to fair skin for example, it may be possible for the class teacher or teaching assistant to apply sun cream to your child. If this is the case, please discuss the matter with your child's class teacher and sign a medical consent form which can be obtained from the school front office.



Key Stages 1 & 2 – Older children, who may also be particularly sensitive to the sun and are able to apply sun cream themselves, may bring sun cream to school. However, it must be labelled with their name and handed to their class teacher for safe keeping.
