#### Maximising the learning opportunities for your child

If your child gets into school the moment the gates open at 8.40, they will benefit from the learning opportunities that are available first thing in the morning. If a child is in class every day for just after 8.40, they gain an additional hour and a quarter of learning each week, which equates to almost 50 hours extra across the year.

Moving your morning routine forward by say10/15 minutes could make a real difference for your child.

Worle, Priory and Winterstoke One Hundred secondary schools all have a start time of 8:40am, so getting into the routine of arriving at HMA at 8:40am will help with transition.

#### Summer Season

- Now we are in the Hayfever season. We are happy to hold extra medication in school for your child, provided you have completed the medical consent form.
- On sunny days please apply 'all day' sun protection cream before your child leaves home.
- We would encourage the wearing of sunhats on sunny days.
- We ask that you send your child to school with their water bottle filled with <u>only</u> <u>fresh water</u>. Thank you very much.

*Foundation Stage* – Should your child be particularly sensitive to the sun due to fair skin for example, it may be possible for the class teacher or teaching assistant to apply sun cream to your child. If this is the case, please discuss the matter with your child's class teacher and sign a medical consent form which can be obtained from the school front office.

*Key Stages 1 & 2* – Older children, who may also be particularly sensitive to the sun and are able to apply sun cream themselves, may bring sun cream to school. However, it must be labelled with their name and handed to their class teacher for safe keeping.

#### <u>Uniform</u>

Please can we remind you that at Herons' Moor we expect all children to be in the correct uniform, please do not let your child wear joggers into school when it is not their PE day. It is also really important that our children wear sensible footwear so they are safe. For health and safety reasons, jewellery is not allowed, apart from watches and stud earrings.

We are proud of how smart our children look in their uniform, we believe it gives the academy an identity and encourages the children to take pride in their appearance. Please make sure that all uniform and PE kit is **labelled with your child's name**.



### Textile Recycling

Due to the success of our recycling over the previous years, we shall be collecting all unwanted, good quality, clean clothes, paired shoes, handbags, belts, jewellery and accessories. So please ask friends and family to start saving their unwanted items to bring into school.
