#### Reminder - Start of the day arrangements.

- Children are expected to arrive at school in good time for the start of the school day. **The gates close at 8.50am.** Although they close at 8.50am we request that you try to arrive well before this, so that the children are in their classes and settled for when learning starts at 8.50am.
- If a child arrives at school after 8.50am they will need to enter via the front office and they will be marked in the register as late.

We introduced the change to the start of day arrangements at the start of September. As with all things new, it took a little while to bed in and for everyone to get used to the "new normal", but we are pleased to report that the streamlined and tighter arrangements have given us the outcomes that we desired. The vast majority of our children are in class promptly on time and are making the most of the additional learning opportunities on offer.

For children in Years 3-6 payment of £2.40 for the Christmas lunch will be charged via Parentpay on the day, please ensure you have enough funds in your account to cover this.

## Reception Intake September 2024 (for children born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 - 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020)

From 1<sup>st</sup> September you may apply for a Reception place for your child if your child was born between the dates above. Applications may be made online at <u>www.n-somerset.gov.uk</u> or you may obtain an application pack from the School Admissions and Transport Team at the Town Hall on 01275 888328. Please note that packs are not available from school. The closing date for the first round of allocations is at Midnight on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024.

Please note a change in our Admissions Policy. If you currently have a child in Year 6, the sibling rule still applies, so you will have more chance of getting your child a place.

Please remember that if your child attends our Nursery, this sadly **DOES NOT** guarantee you a place in Reception, you need to apply for a place in the same manner as all other parents. If you have any questions concerning this procedure please ask a member of staff or contact the Town Hall.

#### **Nursery Applications**

If you would like to apply for a place in our Nursery for September 2024 (for children who have had their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday before September 2024) please complete an application form which is available from the school Front Office. The form must be returned to school before the deadline of January 31<sup>st</sup> 2024 in order to be considered.

#### School uniform

If you have any good quality trousers, leggings, pants, socks, shoes or trainers for KS1 that your child has grown out of, please can we ask you to donate them to the school as we are running out of spares to change children into when needed.
