At Herons' Moor Academy, we want every child to feel safe, happy and cared for. This policy is written helps you to know what to do if someone is unkind to you.

What is bullying?

Bullying is when someone keeps being unkind to on purpose either in person, behind your back or online. It can make you feel scared, sad, worried or upset.

There are different types of bullying:

- Hurting your feelings or leaving you out
- Hitting, kicking or punching
- Sending unkind messages online
- Name-calling or teasing

What to do if you are being bullied:

- Tell them to STOP
- Walk away

Tell a trusted Adult

- Find an adult you trust and talk to them

If you see someone being bullied, you must do the following:

- Tell an adult straightaway
- Don't stay silent - the bullying may continue

Who can you talk to?

- You can talk to any trusted adult - teachers, support staff or parents/carers
- Talking helps us to stop the bullying quickly



What happens when you tell us?

Adults will listen, help you and make sure you feel safe

They will write down what happened so they can record it and stop it from happening again

If bullying continues, consequences will be given.
