- Shout-card sent home to grown-ups

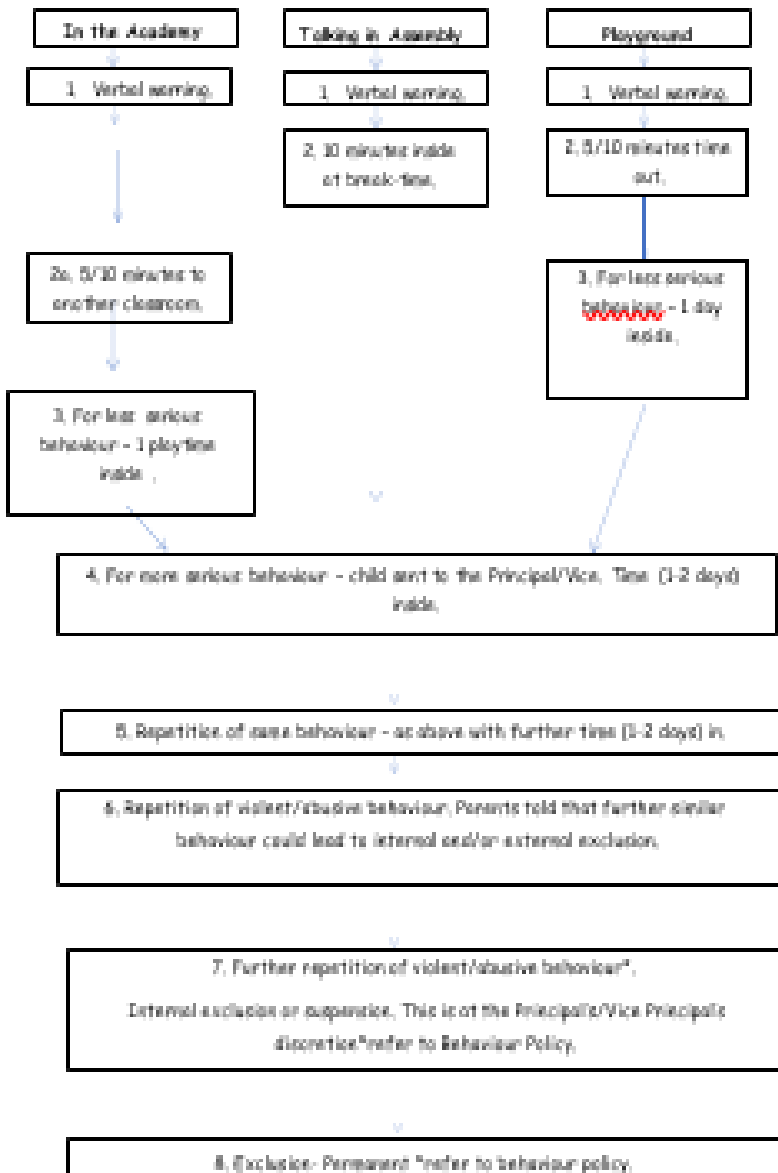
