

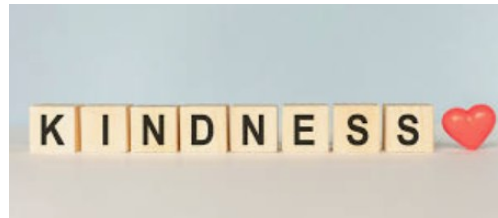

Safeguarding

As a school community, we place great importance on kindness, respect, and empathy. We kindly ask for your continued support in encouraging children to treat others with care and consideration — both **in person and online**.



Children learn so much from the examples set by the adults around them. Talking at home about the impact of words and actions, helping children reflect before they speak or post online, and reinforcing positive behaviour all play a vital role in building respectful relationships.

Kindness helps children feel safe, valued, and confident. It supports their wellbeing, strengthens friendships, and contributes to a positive learning environment.

Focus for Terms 5 and 6

In assembly and in classes, we talked about our whole-school focus for the summer term.

Lining up and moving around the school quietly is important for children because it helps keep everyone safe, calm, and ready to learn.

When children walk calmly and quietly, there is less chance of bumping into others, tripping, or getting hurt. Quiet movement helps teachers see and hear what is happening and respond quickly if there is a problem.

Other classes may be working nearby. Moving quietly shows respect for other children's learning so they are not distracted while reading, thinking, or listening.

Lining up helps children stay with their class. This means no one gets lost and teachers can easily make sure everyone is present and safe.

Quiet movement keeps the school peaceful and calm which helps children feel secure and ready to learn when they arrive at their next activity.

Learning to line up and move quietly helps children practise self control, listening skills, and following instructions—important skills they will use throughout school and life.

In simple terms, lining up and moving quietly helps the school work smoothly, keeps everyone safe, and shows kindness and respect for others.



Rules for Wearing School Uniform

School uniform – Should be always worn (except on PE days when PE kit can be worn) and should be worn with pride. Uniform should be clean and well presented.

Labels – It is essential that all clothes and belongings are clearly labelled with your child's name, this includes bags, PE kits, hats and shoes.

Socks – Socks must be a plain neutral colour.

Jewellery & Watches – no smart watches
Earrings- maximum of one pair of earrings (stud style earrings). These must be removed for PE/Sports activities.

Nails/Nail Varnish – No nail varnish is allowed. Students wearing nail varnish will be asked to remove it. Long acrylic/gel nails are not appropriate for a school environment and pose a health and safety issue at times. We will ask that they are removed.

Hairstyle – Hair to be groomed and a natural, single colour. No unnatural coloured hair dye. No extreme forms of hairstyle are acceptable.

Make-up – No make-up is allowed.

Under layers/skins – If worn must be neutral in colour

Coats – Children must have a coat in school except during hot weather

Sun Hats – Sun hats are required during the summer months.
