#### **Parents' Evening Appointments**

#### **Foundation Stage Open Session**

Following on from the success of our January session, we are running an open session between 4pm – 6pm on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> February. This is an opportunity for anyone considering sending their child/children to our Nursery and/or Reception. The classrooms will be set up for a typical day and the staff will be there for you to meet.



#### **Nursery Applications**

We have places in our excellent Nursery for September 2020. If you have a child who has their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday before September 2020 or know somebody who is looking for a Nursery place, please collect and complete an application form which is available from the school front office.

All children are entitled to  $\bf 15$  hours FREE childcare and education starting the term after their  $\bf 3^{rd}$  birthday.

In addition, some children may also be entitled to **30 hours FREE** childcare and education depending on their circumstances (see gov.uk).

Our Nursery offers **flexible sessions**- children could start as early as **8am** and

finish at **3.30pm**. We provide water, milk and fruit daily and we also offer **hot meals** for children. The Nursery is part of our successful Foundation Stage where children thrive by learning through play.

#### **Textile Recycling**

Due to the success of our recycling over the previous years, we shall be collecting all good quality unwanted clothes, paired shoes, handbags and belts again. The money raised will go towards our Year 3 annual Children's World puppet integration workshop with children from Baytree. So please ask friends and family to start saving

#### Are you interested in training to become a primary school teacher?

Our school is part of a growing number of schools leading the way in school-led teacher training. This is really important to us because it means we can choose the very best talent and develop them into first-rate teachers. Being able to choose who we train as teachers helps us in delivering the best outcomes for pupils in North Somerset.

Herons' Moor Academy is working in collaboration with five other North Somerset primary schools with Somerset SCITT as our accredited partner, and we are recruiting another group of trainee teachers to work in our School Direct consortium from September 2020. We would be very interested in hearing from anybody who is thinking of becoming a teacher. Eligible people need to have a degree, have a passion for teaching and education and the commitment and determination to undertake an intensive year of training, 90% of which is school-based.

If you are interested, the first step is to have a conversation with me as Headteacher. I will be able to tell you more about this exciting teacher training opportunity.
