<u>Reception Intake September 2020 (for children born between 1st September 2015 - 31st August 2016)</u>

From 1st September you may apply for a Reception place for your child if your child was born between the dates above. Applications may be made online at <u>www.n-somerset.gov.uk</u> or you may obtain an application pack from the School Admissions and Transport Team at the Town Hall on 01275 888328. Please note that packs are not available from school. The closing date for the first round of allocations is at Midnight on 15th January 2020.

Please note a change in our Admissions Policy. If you currently have a child in Year 6, the sibling rule still applies, so you will have more chance of getting your child a place.

Please remember that if your child attends our Nursery, this sadly **DOES NOT** guarantee you a place in Reception, you need to apply for a place in the same manner as all other parents. If you have any questions concerning this procedure please ask a member of staff or contact the Town Hall.

Nursery Applications

If you would like to apply for a place in our Nursery for September 2020 (for children who have had their 3rd birthday before September 2020) please complete an application form which is available from the school Front Office. The form must be returned to school before the deadline of January 31st 2020 in order to be considered.

<u> Mobile Phones –</u>



Our School has a Code of conduct for all adults that work/volunteer on site. It is on the website should you wish to look at it. Part of the code relates to the use of electronic communication devices. As a school we work within the guidance regarding the use of mobile phones provided by the Campus wide "Appropriate Use of Electronic Communication Policy". The policy is in place to ensure that mobile phones and similar devices that have cameras are used in staff only areas or off site in public areas. We do appreciate that mobile phones have become central to all of our lives but all us (staff and parents) need to do all that we can

to protect the children of the school. To further enhance the safety of the children that attend Herons' Moor, we would ask that all parents do not use their mobile phones while in the building or on the playground.

<u>Parking</u>

Please can we ask again that when bringing your children to school, that you park in a legal and sensible place like Boots car park and walk through to the school. We have had a few complaints from homeowners near the school with regards to illegal parking, obstructing driveways and even parking in a bus stop especially on Bransby Way. The parking has been particularly dangerous on Thursdays when the coach driver has not been able to drop children off in a safe place after swimming. Please, for the safety of
