# <u>School Christmas Lunch – Tuesday 15th December 2020</u>



We are having our annual Christmas lunch on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> December 2020. Reception and Years 1 and 2 all receive Universal Infant Free School Meals so no payment is required for them, **however**, **you still need to order a Christmas lunch if your child would like one.** You can do this by completing the parentmail form that will be sent out soon, the closing date will be Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> November 2020. We will be unable to take orders for



this on the day as it has to be pre-ordered, therefore any child that has not pre-ordered and has not brought lunch with them will not be able to have Christmas lunch and we will have to call home for a packed lunch to be provided.

For children in Years 3-6 payment of £2.20 for the Christmas lunch will be charged via Parentpay on the day, please ensure you have enough funds in your account to cover this.

# <u>Reception Intake September 2021 (for children born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2016 - 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017)</u>

From 1<sup>st</sup> September you may apply for a Reception place for your child if your child was born between the dates above. Applications may be made online at <u>www.n-somerset.gov.uk</u> or you may obtain an application pack from the School Admissions and Transport Team at the Town Hall on 01275 888328. Please note that packs are not available from school. The closing date for the first round of allocations is at Midnight on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2021.

Please note a change in our Admissions Policy. If you currently have a child in Year 6, the sibling rule still applies, so you will have more chance of getting your child a place.

Please remember that if your child attends our Nursery, this sadly **DOES NOT** guarantee you a place in Reception, you need to apply for a place in the same manner as all other parents. If you have any questions concerning this procedure please ask a member of staff or contact the Town Hall.

#### **Nursery Applications**

If you would like to apply for a place in our Nursery for September 2021 (for children who have had their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday before September 2021) please complete an application form which is available from the school Front Office. The form must be returned to school before the deadline of January 31<sup>st</sup> 2021 in order to be considered.

#### Keeping Children Safe.

Thank you so much to everyone who is following our latest guidance – wearing face masks to pick up/drop off, not arriving until the allocated time and not crowding around the gates. This is really helping to keep everyone safe.


#### **Parking**
